

OFFICE HOURS

Office hours differ from clinic hours. Each midwife's schedule varies based on the needs of the clinic and community. The hours below are when an admin staff will be able to assist you:

PRENATAL APPOINTMENTS

Clinic appointments are available from Monday to Wednesday. Appointment times vary depending on who is in clinic, and what is needed out in the community. Typically, appointments are offered between 8am to 4pm. Times vary as your Midwives may be on call, attending deliveries, providing home visits and labour assessments outside of clinic hours.

Regular appointments following the intake are approximately 20-30 minutes in length.

Booking your FTS (NT) Ultrasound & Bloodwork

The window to complete eFTS (genetic screening) is between 11 to 13 weeks. It is important that these are completed either on the same day, or within a few days of each other. You must complete both parts of the test prior to the cut off date.

Please complete your ultrasound **FIRST**, followed by the bloodwork. This will ensure there are no delays in getting your final eFTS results. The lab will need the genetics form with the ultrasound information.

Fetal Ultrasound for Keepsake Videos

Health Canada is recommending parents not to expose their unborn babies to fetal ultrasound for the purpose of making “keepsake” videos.

The procedure uses very short bursts of sound vibrations that travel as waves through the body in a series of focused beams. When the procedure is used to obtain images for medical purposes, it is called diagnostic fetal ultrasound.

Diagnostic fetal ultrasound provides important medical information, such as the size, age and state of health of the baby. The clinical use of fetal ultrasounds has grown rapidly and it has an excellent safety record.

When fetal ultrasound is done for a keepsake video, no medical information is provided to justify exposing the baby to ultrasound.
